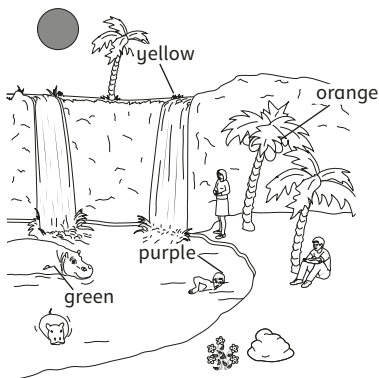


Unit 6 Movers Listening Part 2

Transcript

R Part 2 Listen and look. There is one example.

PAUSE 00'03"

M: Hello. Can I ask you some questions about classes at the sports centre, please?

Fch: OK.

M: First. What's your name?

Fch: Lucy Flynn.

M: Lucy Flynn. Is that F-L-Y double N?

Fch: That's right.

PAUSE 00'03"

R Can you see the answer? Now you listen and write.

PAUSE 00'03"

[REPEAT FROM HERE.]

R One

M: Right, Lucy, which classes do you go to here?

Fch: I have a swimming class.

M: Swimming, OK. And do you enjoy that?

Fch: Very much.

M: Good.

PAUSE 00'08"

R Two

M: When do you have your class, Lucy?

Fch: On Saturday morning – no, that's wrong. It's in the afternoon now.

M: OK, and you have it every week?

Fch: Yes, on Saturday afternoon.

PAUSE 00'08"

R Three

M: What's the name of your teacher?

Fch: It's Mr Hart. He's very nice.

M: Do you spell that H-A-R-T?

Fch: Yes, that's right.

M: Great.

PAUSE 00'08"

R Four

M: Now, how do you get here, Lucy?

Fch: I come with my father in the car.

M: Does he come in and watch the class?

Fch: No, he sits in the car and reads his book!

PAUSE 00'08"

R Five

M: Now the last question. Do you do a lot of sports?

Fch: Yes, I play tennis, hockey and basketball.

M: And which is your favourite?

Fch: Oh, I like tennis best.

M: Thank you very much, Lucy.

PAUSE 00'08"

R Now listen to Part 2 again.

PAUSE 00'03"

[REPEAT PART 2 WITH ONLY 00'05" PAUSES]
